	Wisdom of the World (Flesh)	Wisdom of the Cross (Spirit)
Data	<i>Courtney is mad about doing her jobs.</i>	
What do I see?	An angry, rebellious teenager.	I'm not sure.
Who's at the center?	Paul. No need for the Spirit. All is clear.	The Spirit. I am at the edge of the story. I need to wait on the Spirit, to give him space.
What do I do?	Talk. Correct Courtney's errors.	Wait, pray, ask questions.
What do I say?	"Courtney, we've agreed on you doing this."	I wonder, <i>What is wrong? What should I say?</i> To Courtney: "Is anything wrong?"
My Attitude	Nice but demanding.	Wondering, watching, waiting.
Feel of Activity	Clear, confident, quick.	Messy, slow, uncertain.
Feel of Time	Initially quick, but in time, slow.	Initially slow, but in time, quick.
Feeling of Safety	Good.	Risky.
The Effect on Community	I divide by gossiping, "Courtney is driving me nuts."	I unite with Courtney by moving towards her.
My Heart Cry	"Do your jobs!" ("Do this and live.")	"Abba, Father" (Gal 4:6). The cry of the confused and vulnerable.
Final Result	Separation	Reconciliation
